LAST MEETING:

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March was the AGM, and new President, Ken Daniels, was handed the President's Chain of Office by outgoing President, Verna Harford. The Club still needs a Vice President to learn the ropes for next year. Most of last year's Committee remain, but we also need a Guest Speakers' Convenor. Graeme McIntosh has agreed to be responsible for Publicity this year.

Guest Speaker was Greg Moyle

whose topic was **"NZ Memorial Museum Trust – Le Quesnoy".** Greg first visited Le Quesnoy in 1999, a very ordinary little French town. NZ forces had spent from 1916 – 1918 there, trying to liberate the town – not destroy it - but German forces had occupied it for years. The ramparts are 33' tall, with a moat, designed by **Vauban**, the king's fortress architect in the 17th Century. But on 4th November



1918 the wall was scaled by Leslie Averil, an intelligence officer, using a ladder. 700 Germans surrendered.
